The call for mobility of 2 Egyptian students from the Faculty of Tourism and Hotels, Alexandria University to University of Piraeus- Greece is now open.

The mobility aims to provide the opportunity for 2 Egyptian students from the Faculty of Tourism and Hotels to study for one semester (winter semester 2025/2026: 4 months at the School of Economics, Business and International Studies (Tourism studies) University of Piraeus- Greece, or at the Consortium of International Credit Mobility including the following institutions:

Requirements to apply:

- Students of third and fourth years of the department of Tourism studies and Hotel studies in the Faculty of Tourism- Alexandria University.
- Students of second, third and fourth years of the THHM program in the Faculty of Tourism- Alexandria University.
- Master Students

Applicants need to submit:

- 1- Transcript and study record
- 2- Certificate of English language (ILETS 5- ITP 450- AUEPT 70, other English language certificates have to be approved from selection committee)
- 3- Motivation letter
- 4- 2 reference letters
- 5- Copy of passport

All papers should be submitted to the secretary of the THHM program; Mrs Sara , in a file with the applicant's name, mobile number and email.

- An interview will be held for all applicants for the final nomination (exact date will be announced)

- **Deadline to apply is on the 15th of April 2024.**

- **Benefits:**

- 3400 euro for the whole mobility duration.
- 275 euro for return plane ticket.

Money will be paid to students after almost three weeks from arrival

Students will need to provide their own health insurance covering 30.000 euro (this is usually included in all Egyptian passports).

After selection, accepted students will be required to prepare: health insurance, visa, application form and learning agreement.
