

Announcement

The call for the mobility of 1 Egyptian student from the Faculty of Tourism and Hotels, Alexandria University to Philipps University- Marburg- Germany is now open.

The mobility aims to provide the opportunity for 1 Egyptian student from the Faculty of Tourism and Hotels to study for one semester (Summer semester 2025: 4 months from March to the end of July) at Philipps University in Marburg- Germany.



Who can apply?

- Teaching assistants at the Faculty of Tourism and Hotels- Alexandria University.
- Students from different departments and programs of the faculty.
- Top-up category of students such as:
Students with disabilities or chronic disease- students with children- students of parents who don't have university degrees- employed students- students with economic disadvantages.

The required documents and application process:

- The call is open till 31 October 2024.
- Applicants need to submit:
 - 1- Transcript and study record.
 - 2- Certificate of English language level (IELTS - ITP - AUEPT).
 - 3- Motivation letter.
 - 4- 2 reference letters.
 - 5- Copy of passport (If available).

All papers should be submitted to the Guiding Department secretary in a file with the applicant's name and contact information.

- An interview will be held for all applicants for the final nomination.
- The nomination will be sent to Philipps University and when approved the selected student will be informed.
- A learning agreement must be filled out for chosen students.

For one semester of exchange, students have to study courses for 30 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) credits.

The monthly grant is about 850 Euro, but the students will receive 70% of their total grant at the beginning of their mobility (in March/April for the summer semester-September/ October for the winter semester) and the remaining amount of 30% at the end of the semester. The amount reimbursed for travel expenses depends on the distance between the home university and the receiving university (275-820 Euros). Money will be paid to students after about 3 weeks of arrival.

If the selected students want to attend the pre-semester German language course, they should book for the course and receive a booking confirmation in the letter of acceptance that will be sent from the hosting university.

After selection, accepted students will be required to prepare health insurance, visa, application form, and learning agreement.
